

NINDS SEPA priorities

- NINDS expects to support educational activities that encourage individuals from diverse backgrounds, including those from groups underrepresented in the neuroscience field
- Programs should align with the NINDS goals of the <u>Strategic Plan for Training and Workforce Diversity</u>
- NINDS will support...
 - Research educational activities that address or seek fundamental knowledge about the brain and nervous system in the healthy and diseased brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nerves and informal science education activities the highlight knowledge to reduce the burden of neurological disease for all people
 - Activities focused on understanding and addressing disparities in neurologic health and health outcomes in disparate populations
